

Short biography Pantelis Antonakis MD, Ph.D.

Pantelis Antonakis is the academic fellow with full surgery consultant privileges in the 2nd Department of Surgery Athens Medical School, "Aretaieion Hospital", Athens Greece

He has worked as a Consultant both in the private and the public sector mainly focused on laparoscopic and robotic, elective and emergency cases, including but not limited to benign and malignant upper gastrointestinal tract, colorectal, hepatobiliary and adrenal surgery. He is also the lead surgeon in bariatric surgery in Aretaieion Hospital and the main surgeon performing laparoscopic hernia repairs.

From 1997 to 2008 he was actively involved in the Laboratory of Surgical Research of the First Department of Propaedeutic Surgery, Hippocration Hospital, Athens Medical School. During this period of time he became familiar with basic and advanced laboratory techniques (immunohistochemistry, ELISA, PCR, DNA sequencing, flow cytometry, etc), and medical statistics. From 2020 to today he is involved in the Surgical Laboratory of 2nd Department of Surgery of Athens Medical School, at Aretaieion Hospital.

He is the author of more than 44 publications published in CC journals with more than 1876 citations.
